RE: Power Generation Construction & Finance

Your Excellency,

Bright Trade Corporation and our financing associates are willing and able to invest in the power generation sector in Syria. With your approval, we and our associates will finance, design, construct, operate and maintain a 1,000–1,200 MW power plant on the Syrian coast under a build, own and operate (BOO) basis.

To ensure the success of this proposed long-term project; an appropriate coastal land shall be required and provided by the Ministry to build the proposed power station in addition to a water desalination plant for cooling and possible other uses.

We shall enter into a Power Purchase (PPA) Agreement with the Syrian Ministry of Electricity to fully purchase all the generated electric power from our constructed power station. We shall also need all the appropriate Government support, allowed concessions and encouragement. Additionally, a Sovereign Guarantee would greatly facilitate the process.

For combined-cycle power plants we are willing to source the supply all the necessary fuels via the Ministry of Electricity, Arab Republic of Syria or other international external sources, whichever is more cost effective.

Subject to the approval of the terms of formal agreements being concluded, we are willing to commence a process to enable us to install and commission the three, possibly four 320 Megawatts electricity (MW(e)) power generators with a total output capacity of 1,000-1,200 MW(e) of electricity. The permanent location of power stations will be decided in due course jointly with the Syrian Ministry of Electricity.
